YOUTH TRAVEL BASEBALL Stoughton Area Youth Baseball (SAYB)

Players looking for additional games and/or a more competitive environment should also sign up for the Stoughton Area Youth Baseball (SAYB) Travel Program. The goal of SAYB is to advance the quality of Stoughton Baseball by offering knowledgeable coaching and competitive play against other communities.

Teams are offered for players at the age of 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13 years old. Players must also participate in the Little League program. Players are expected to attend team practices and play in weekend games and tournaments.

Pre-registration is required and the number of teams formed is dependent upon the number of players and coaches.

The 9-10 year old program (\$100.00) will feature additional practices, additional single games and typically a few weekend tournaments.

The 11 old program (\$135.00) features additional practices, typically 3 to 4 weekend tournaments and additional games.

The 12 old program (\$160.00) features additional practices, 4 to 6 weekend tournaments and additional games.

NEW The 13 old program (\$60.00) features additional practices and 4 to 6 weekend tournaments. Tryout fees, \$60 (uniform and hat), and additional fees will be collected for tournaments (approx. \$100). If player does not make the tournament team, fees will be reimbursed.

SAYB Additional Notes:

- ▶ Additional fees may be required and families are responsible for their own travel expenses. Most games and tournaments are well within driving distance.
- ▶ SAYB reserves the option to assign players to teams where they will best succeed and progress.

Pony League for 7th Grade (\$110.00)

This competitive league is a transition to the full-size diamond as games are played on intermediate fields with 75-foot-bases and 55-foot pitching. Teams typically play two games per week, with away games in nearby communities. All registered players are placed on a team.

A tournament team will be formed from league teams and will play additional games and tournaments.

Players are expected to attend pre-season & in-season practices.

League is operated by Stoughton Area Little League (SALL). All players receive t-shirt and cap. Register players for the grade they are currently attending. Leagues have player limits due to city field availability.

T Ball Program for Current Kindergartners Fee: \$45.00
Eight game season with one game per week played on Saturday mornings. Games times are 9:00 AM starting June 4th through July 18th. The first 104 registered players are guaranteed team placement.

Machine Pitch League for 1st & 2nd Grade Fee: \$55.00
Hitting off the pitching machine is safe and builds confidence. Twelve game season with two games per week on Mondays and Wednesdays at Racetrack Park. Game times are 5:45 and 7:00 pm beginning June 2nd through July 8th. Practices will begin on May 18th. The first 144 registered players are guaranteed placement.

Minor League for 3rd & 4th Grade Fee: \$65.00
Player pitch league stresses development and team work. Twelve game season with two games per week (Tues & Thur) at Oak Knoll and Racetrack Parks. Games times are 5:30 and 7:15 pm and have a 90 minute time limit. Season runs May 11th through mid July with practices starting in late April. The first 130 registered players are guaranteed team placement.

Major League for 5th & 6th Grade Fee: \$65.00
Player pitch league stresses development and team work. Twelve game season with two games per week (Mon & Wed) at Oak Knoll and Mandt Parks. Games times are 5:30 and 7:15 pm and have a 90 minute time limit. Season runs May 10th through July with practices starting in late April. The first 96 registered players are guaranteed team placement.
