YOUTH TRAVEL BASEBALL Stoughton Area Youth Baseball (SAYB)

Travel baseball is designed for players looking for additional games in a more competitive environment. The goal of SAYB is to advance the quality of Stoughton Baseball by offering knowledgeable coaching and competitive play against other communities.

Teams are offered for players at the ages of 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13 years old. Players must also participate in the Stoughton Little League program. Players are expected to attend team practices and play in weekend games and tournaments.

After SALL/Pony evaluations, players who qualify will be notified of SAYB tryout date (SAYB tryouts will be March 24th @ the Stoughton High School).

The 9 year old program (\$140.00) will feature additional practices, additional single games and typically 3 weekend tournaments.

The 10 year old program (\$140.00) will feature additional practices, additional single games and at least 4 tournaments.

The 11 old program (\$160.00) features additional practices, typically 4-5 weekend tournaments and/or additional games.

The 12 old program (\$160.00) features additional practices, 5 to 6 weekend tournaments and additional games.

The 13 old program features additional practices and 4-6 weekend tournaments. Uniform and hat will be included. Additional fees will be collected for tournaments (approx. \$160).

SAYB Additional Notes:

- ▶ Additional fees may be required and families are responsible for their own travel expenses. Most games and tournaments are well within driving distance.
- ▶ SAYB reserves the option to assign players to teams where they will best succeed and progress.

Pony League for 7th Grade (\$110.00)

This competitive league is a transition to the full-size diamond as games are played on intermediate fields with 75-foot-bases and 55-foot pitching. Teams typically play two games per week, with away games in nearby communities.

A tournament team will be formed from league teams and will play additional games and tournaments. **Players are expected to attend pre-season and in-season practices.**

LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL Programs (K-6th)

League is operated by Stoughton Area Little League (SALL). All players receive t-shirt and cap. Register players for the grade they are currently attending. Leagues have player limits due to city field availability.

Coach Pitch Program for Current Kindergartners Fee: \$50.00
Eight game season with one game per week played on Saturday mornings. Games times are 9:00 AM starting late May though July. The first 104 registered players are guaranteed team placement.

Machine League for 1st Grade Fee: \$60.00
Hitting off the pitching machine is safe and builds confidence. Two games/practices per week on (Mon. & Wed.) at Racetrack Park. Game times are 5:45 and 7:00 pm. The first 100 registered players are guaranteed placement.

NEW Amateur League for 2nd Grade Fee: \$60.00
This league begins with Machine Pitch, transitions to Coach Pitch and ends with Kid Pitch. Baseball fundamentals will be emphasized. Two games/practices per week on (Mon. & Wed.) at Racetrack Park. Game times are 5:45 and 7:00 pm. The first 100 registered players are guaranteed placement.

Minor League for 3rd & 4th Grade Fee: \$70.00
Player pitch league stresses development and team work. Two games/practices per week (Tues. & Thu.) at Oak Knoll and Racetrack Parks. Games times are 5:30 and 7:15 pm and have a 90 minute time limit. Season runs early May through late June with practices starting in April. The first 130 registered players are guaranteed team placement.

Major League for 5th & 6th Grade Fee: \$70.00
Player pitch league stresses development and team work. Two games/practices per week (Mon. & Wed.) at Oak Knoll and Mandt Parks. Games times are 5:30 and 7:15 pm and have a 90 minute time limit. Season runs early May through late June with practices starting in April. The first 96 registered players are guaranteed team placement.
